Marina Information

Berthing

Short and long term berthing options are available for all vessels up to 80m. Berths are available from 12pm on day of arrival to 11am on checkout. Early check in is subject to availability. As a busy commercial marina, we are unable to provide berth allocations in advance. Whilst we do try to accommodate specific berthing requests, please understand this may not always be possible. For after-hours check-in please contact us during office hours for your berth allocation and our Night Duty Supervisor will be able to assist with your arrival.

Insurance

All vessels staying in the marina must have current fully comprehensive insurance including P&I (Protection & Indemnity) cover to the value of A\$10M. Insurance must be from a provider that is licensed to operate in Australia under the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA). A copy of the vessel's current insurance documentation is required, along with a completed Berthing Agreement, prior to checking in.

VHF Radio

Coral Sea Marina monitors VHF Channel 09 between 8.00am - 4.30pm. Call Sign 'Coral Sea Marina'. Guests are required, at all times, whilst moving around the marina to monitor VHF channel 09.

Dockhand Assistance

Our dockhands can greet you at your berth to catch lines and assist with your arrival/departure. If you are looking to get a gas bottle refill or if you wish to schedule a time for the fuel dock, our dockhands can also assist you with this. Please contact the marina office should you require dockhand assistance.

Access Cards

Upon your arrival you will be issued with an access card which provides access to your berth and guest amenities. Every evening from 5pm to 5am the gates on our marina arms are locked. On departure, please return your access card to the marina office. After-hours, marina access cards can be returned to the drop boxes located on the marina arm gates or out the front of the marina office. A \$50 fee will be charged for any lost access cards.

Amenities

Shower and bathroom amenities are available in both the south and north marina villages, as well as at Ocean Club. Your marina access card will provide entry to these amenities. All amenities are cleaned daily. Please report any issues to the marina office.

Shore Power

15amp shore power is available at each berth. Use of multiple 15amp/ single phase power incurs an additional daily charge. 3-phase power (32amp, 63amp or 125amp) will incur an aggregated electricity fee based on consumption.

Electrical Leads (Test & Tag)

It is mandatory that all electrical leads connected to our shore power must be tested by a qualified electrician and have a valid tag displayed on the lead. All single-phase power leads are to have a current rating of no less than 15amp for safety requirements.

Fuelling

Due to the high volume of vessel movements, it is essential to make a fuel booking in advance between 8am - 4.30pm. To reduce congestion, we allocate half an hour for each vessel to utilise the fuel and water facilities. The fuel wharf is available for public use with 24/7 access. Card payment facilities are available on the fuel wharf.

LPG Refills

Gas refills are available in both north and south marina villages. To arrange a refill, please contact the marina office. Fees apply.

Laundry

Laundry facilities are located at Ocean Club and in the north village. The laundry at Ocean Club is coin operated with a change machine available. The laundry in the north village accepts card payments only.

Trolleys

Trolleys are available to help with provisioning, luggage and refuse disposal. Trolleys are located in the north village, south village, on N arm and at Ocean Club. We kindly ask that trolleys are returned to trolley bays after use and not left on the docks or at berths.

Courtesy Cars

Private marina guests are able to book one of our courtesy cars for two hours to assist with provisioning and accessing local suppliers. To make a booking please contact the marina office. Please note that you must have checked in prior to making a booking.





Refuse and Recycling

Coral Sea Marina is proud of our International Clean Marina Level 3 accreditation and we are committed to providing refuse facilities to encourage recycling. We have refuse/ recycling facilities in both the north and south villages. There are general waste, mixed recycling and cardboard bins available. Please separate your refuse correctly. Refuse is cleared on a daily basis. In addition, Coral Sea Marina will recycle any small batteries, please deliver to the marina office.

Security / CCTV

Coral Sea Marina has comprehensive 24-hour CCTV coverage on all docks and throughout the marina precinct for your safety, as well as a Night Duty Supervisor that patrols the marina regularly after-hours. The Night Duty Supervisor can be contacted on 0488 140 923.

Pump Out

Due to our Clean Marina status, nil discharge is permitted within the marina. Pump out facilities are available 24/7 at the fuel wharf. During office hours, please ensure you make a booking to access the fuel wharf for pump out.

Car Parkina

We have parking available in both the north and south marina villages. Payment via machine or EasyPark app is available for short term parking. For long term parking permit rates, please contact the marina office.

Disabled Access

Wheelchair access is available to marina berths, guest amenities and selected restaurants and retail outlets in the marina villages.

Mail and Parcel Deliveries

If you are berthed at the marina, we will accept postal deliveries on your behalf at the marina office. Please ensure that your name, vessel name and contact number are clearly marked on any deliveries and we will advise you when they have arrived.

Wi-Fi

Guest Wi-Fi is available at various locations throughout the marina. For guest Wi-Fi login details please contact our Guest Services team. Wi-Fi Hotspots are at Ocean Club and The Lookout Lounge.

Transfer Service

We offer our marina guests an option for either a private or shared transfer service to and from Whitsunday Coast airport. Fees apply and bookings can be made via our marina office.

Helicopter Tours/ Transfers

We can arrange helicopter transfers to and from Whitsunday Coast and Hamilton Island airports directly to our private helipads at Coral Sea Marina. We can also arrange helicopter scenic flights to allow guests to experience the Whitsunday Islands and Great Barrier Reef from the air.

Gift Shop

Our Gift Shop can be found at the marina office and online via the marina website. Stock includes Coral Sea Marina merchandise, keep-cups, water bottles, sun shirts, hats, sarongs, art and more. Pick up a souvenier or a gift for family and friends.

Tour/ Activity Bookings

Should you wish to book any tours, accommodation or restaurants whilst staying with us at the marina, our Guest Services team are happy to make those arrangements on your behalf.

Contractors and Tradespeople


A Contractor Induction Program has been introduced to ensure a consistent high standard of service provided by contractors and tradespeople is maintained. In accordance with WHS legislation, prior to work commencing, Coral Sea Marina requires all contractors and tradespeople to check in at the marina office and complete the required induction program. Provision of insurance and qualification certificates are mandatory and all power tool leads must be tested and tagged. Inducted contractors will be identified with a contractor lanyard and access card. A \$50 deposit per card is payable at time of induction. Boat owners are responsible for ensuring any tradespeople they engage to work on their vessel have completed our induction program.

Resort Access

Private marina guests are able to access Coral Sea Resort facilities, including swimming pool and beach, free of charge. Please present your marina access card upon arrival to the resort. In addition, all marina guests are entitled to a 10% discount at The Rocks - Restaurant & Bar. Simply present your marina access card when making payment.

Extend Your Stay

Should you wish to extend your stay please notify us at your earliest convenience. Whilst we try to accommodate all booking extensions, due to other forward bookings this may not always be possible or we may require you to relocate to a new berth for the remainder of your stay. It is advisable to enquire in advance for future visits, due to high occupancy.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBLITY

The Whitsunday Islands form part of the world-heritage listed Great Barrier Reef Marine Park and as a business we are focused on reducing our impact on the environment, encouraging the long term health of the reef and preserving the biodiversity of the National Parks which surround us.

Environmental Initiatives

Purging Plastics: After signing a pledge to become single-use plastic free by 2025, we are working towards purging all single use plastics from within the precinct. We provide all guests with an enviro bag on check-in; our hydration stations encourage guests to reuse water bottles; we sell enviro water bottles and coffee cups at the marina office: we eliminated plastic straws from all food outlets and water bottles from our event venues.

Seagrass Nursery: We have partnered with CQ University and the Reef Island Initiative, to establish a Seagrass Nursery site here at Coral Sea Marina. The project will facilitate the collecting, cultivating and germinating of seagrass seeds to enhance the seagrass meadows in Pioneer Bay.

Ditch The Flick: The "Ditch the Flick" campaign, as part of Tangaroa Blue Foundation's ReefClean program, is designed to drive behavioural changes amongst smokers on the Great Barrier Reef, reducing cigarette butt litter and offering a better way of disposing of cigarette butts. You will notice the campaign stickers on the butt bins around the marina.

Strain The Drain: A "drain buddy" has been installed in the north marina. The project is designed to collect and monitor litter entering the stormwater system with data being used to guide source reduction programs. It also acts as a trap to capture litter from entering the stormwater system and eventually our oceans.

Whales of the Whitsundays: We are proud Platinum sponsors of the region's bid to gain Whale Heritage Site status. The initiative certifies destinations that support and demonstrate the importance of cetaceans (whales and dolphins) in their ocean habitats. If successful, the region will be the world's first World Heritage area (Great Barrier Reef) with Whale Heritage Status.

Clean Marina

Coral Sea Marina is a certified Clean Marina Level III.

Since we are located on the doorstep to the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park, we are passionate about conserving our marine environment and ask that our guests assist us in this cause.

What can you do to keep our marina clean?

- Reuse and recycle both north and south marina villages
 have recycling facilities for paper, cardboard, glass,
 aluminium cans and hard plastics. We encourage all guests
 to make full use of the marina recycling facilities during their
 stay.
- 2. No fishing our marina is certified Fish Friendly, so no fishing is permitted within the marina precinct.
- Nothing to be thrown overboard please contain all your rubbish (including liquids) and dispose of it in the correct manner.
- 4. Sewage all sewage must be disposed of at the pump-out facilities on the fuel dock. Nil discharge is permitted in the maring.
- Conserve water if you see a tap dripping, please turn it off.
 Don't leave hoses unattended when filling water tanks and report any damaged hoses and/or fittings to the marina office

Marina Code Of Conduct

Welcome to Coral Sea Marina, we hope you enjoy your stay with us. To ensure your safety, the safety of your vessel and all other marina guests we ask you adhere to the following Code of Conduct. A full version of the marina rules can be found in your Berthing Agreement.

1. Vessel

- · The vessel must be kept in a sound, safe, secure, watertight and seaworthy condition.
- The vessel will only be admitted to the marina if it is in a seaworthy condition and is under its own power.
- You must not discharge anything of whatever nature into the waters in the marina.
- You must keep the decks of the vessel free and clear of debris, bottles, papers, trash and other unsightly material at all times.
- · You must ensure that the vessel is secured appropriately when not in use for any period of time.

2. Berth

- You must keep the berth, and any other area of the marina used by you from time to time, in a clean state and free from rubbish at all times.
- Only approved power leads which are compliant with *Australian Standard AS 3760:2022 In-service safety inspection and testing of electrical equipment*, have been checked for correct polarity, have been tested and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor within a reasonable time prior to the start date and inspected by us can be used to connect to the power supply which runs to the berth.

3. Conduct

- You must ensure that no unauthorized persons or external contractors access the marina.
- Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times while you are within the marina precinct.
- Noise should be kept to a minimum at all times.
- Swimming, diving and/or fishing within the marina is prohibited.
- Children must be supervised and accompanied by adults at all times while in the marina precinct.
- Animals must be leashed/caged at all times. A Pets Onboard form must be completed at the start of your stay. Animals, excluding service or assistane animals, are not permitted inside any marina facility, including but not limited to the marina office, bathrooms, toilets, Ocean Club, the Lookout Lounge or the gym.
- No use of any skateboards, scooters, segways, bicycles or other wheeled personal transportation objects is permitted on marina walkways, pontoons, pathways or in pedestrian-only zones.
- No feeding of fish or birds within the marina is permitted.
- · Consumption of alcohol is prohibited within the marina precinct, except within licensed premises or onboard the vessel.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the marina precinct except in those areas (if any) which are designated as being smoking areas. No cigarette buts are to be disposed overboard.
- · You must not do anything that is immoral, noxious, offensive, hazardous or likely to cause nuisance or injury to any person.
- You shall be solely responsible for the conduct of your associates.
- Laundry of any type or items of apparel or equipment must not be hung out to dry or air in public view aboard the vessel or any part of the marina precinct.
- No chemicals, flammable or volatile liquids or substances (including gas) may be stored in the vessel.
- · All sewerage must only be disposed of in the sewage pump out station at the marina.
- Nothing must be thrown overboard the vessel while it is in the marina, including but not limited to fish scraps.
- You must not display any 'for sale' or other similar sign.
- You must not undertake or perform any works or alterations to the vessel including but not limited to sanding, sandblasting, painting, hot works, welding, hull cleaning, fitting out or refitting whatsoever.
- You must not allow any contractors or tradespeople to carry out works to the vessel or otherwise within the marina precinct unless they have been approved to work within the marina by us.
- You must not allow any vessel other than the registered vessel to use the berth.

4. Extreme Weather Preparedness

You must promptly comply with, and be aware of your obligations under, the marina's Extreme Weather Procedure.

5. General

The fire fighting equipment within the marina must not be used for any purpose other than fire fighting, without our prior written consent.
