



CORAL SEA MARINA – GUEST COVID SAFE PLAN

The purpose of this document is to ensure all guests of Coral Sea Marina are aware of our current COVID Safe practices and directives.

COVID Safe Practices

- Coral Sea Marina is a COVID Clean Practising Accredited Business and standard COVID Cleaning protocols are already in place across the site
- All guests are required to check in via the QLD Check-In app and to put on a mask **prior** to entering the marina office, Ocean Club Business Centre and Lookout Lounge
- We also ask that all guests use the hand sanitiser stations available and maintain social distancing when moving through the marina
- If a guest presents with symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or is deemed a 'close contact', follow the current advice from Queensland Health: <https://www.covid19.qld.gov.au>

On-Board Quarantine / Isolation

The Harbourmaster has confirmed that anyone who must quarantine or isolate onboard their vessel is now permitted by the Queensland Government to do so if the vessel is fit for purpose.

In the event you are required to quarantine or isolate onboard your vessel in accordance with the directions from Queensland Health, we recommend you do so onboard outside of the marina.

If you choose to remain in the marina onboard your vessel during your quarantine or isolation period, you must follow the marina directions below in addition to the latest guidance from Queensland Health:

- Do not disembark the vessel except for the reasons permitted by Queensland Health
- Do not enter the marina office - please ring for any assistance required
- Do not use any private or public amenities, Ocean Club, the laundry, The Lookout Lounge or the Courtesy Cars
- Ensure any food/ supplies delivered to the vessel are done so without a person onboarding/ disembarking
- Fresh water refills, fuel bookings, rubbish removal, LPG refills and black water pump-outs can be arranged with the marina office subject to staff availability; make your quarantine or isolation status known to the office team so that a CSMR staff member may assist wearing appropriate PPE; onboard quarantine assistance fees will apply
- Only vessel owners and their immediate family and/or full-time crew are permitted to quarantine onboard the vessel in the marina
- Be advised that any breach of this policy may result in the vessel being required to vacate the marina

An onboard quarantine assistance fee will be charged for the quarantine support outlined above, which will require extra staffing. The onboard quarantine assistance fee will be \$50 per hour, with a one hour minimum.

Assistance will only be provided via prior arrangement and will be subject to staff availability. Please contact the marina office for onboard quarantine assistance and confirm which services you require. Fees will be added to your berthing account.
